Overview

The Certified Government Chief Information Officer™ (CGCIO™) Program of GMIS International is a comprehensive educational program designed to standardize and enhance knowledge in critical areas involved in public sector information technology leadership and management. The certification program is governed by the GMIS International Board of Directors. Instruction, technical and administrative support for the program is provided by Rutgers School of Public Affairs and Administration and the Public Technology Institute. To be certified as a CGCIO™ requires successful completion of 240 hours of education that includes: live and Online instruction; Group and Individual Projects and a Capstone Project.

Your organization must be a GMIS member in good standing for you to be eligible for this scholarship. The class will begin in early fall. Please make sure that you read and understand the attached documents which include the CIO Certification (CGCIO™) Program document and the CGCIO™ Code of Ethics document.

Scholarships valued at \$1,600 towards the total cost of \$3,200 each will be awarded for this year's class. The scholarships are provided by ***NJGMIS Technology Education Conference Foundation (NJGMIS TEC)***. Scholarship applications will be reviewed by the NJGMIS TEC Board of Directors. Scholarship awards will be at the discretion of the NJGMIS TEC Board of Directors whose decision is final.
